Orff Schulwerk is a teaching model that builds musicianship in every learner by releasing creativity that extends far beyond the music classroom. Carl Orff and Gunild Keetman conceived an approach to building musicianship in every learner through the integration of music, movement, speech, and drama. In Orff Schulwerk classrooms, children begin with what they do instinctively: play, Imitation, experimentation, and personal expression occur naturally as students become confident, life-long musicians and creative problem solvers. The Orff approach to teaching is a model for optimal learning in 21st Century classrooms.
